At the race site the Race Secretariat can only issue single event "Daily" Superlicenses. However, in order to do so, the rider must have a valid licence delivered by a National Authority recognized by the UIM and following the UIM activities in Aquabike racing.

The single event "Daily" World Superlicense fee (Rule 203.02.04) is 50 €.

INSURANCE

Riders must provide a valid attestation of Civil Responsibility insurance in and out of race (as requested by UIM Rule 203.02.02) for a minimum amount of 1.000.000 € and with the exception of coverage of damages caused by the pilots and their Aquabike amongst drivers.

For contracted riders only:

Contracted and supported riders and crew will be accommodated in twin rooms from August 13th to 18th upon receipt of RL before June 30th.

Airport – Hotel Transfer
 ABP will organise pick-up and drop-off from and to Silangit International Airport (DTB) and
 Medan Airport (KNO) upon receipt of flight details before June 30th.

INSPECTION

Technical Inspection shall be according to UIM rules.

It is the Team's responsibility to report to the inspection area allowing adequate time for both preand post-race inspection and registration based on announced time schedule.

Paddock crews will be responsible for assisting in weighing and in all inspection procedures.

The UIM ABP organisation, its members, race sponsors and crane/forklift owners or operators accept no responsibility for injury, damage or any loss incurred while operating cranes or other equipment (whether weighing, lifting or other), at race site.

PIT PROCEDURES

Access to pit area will only be allowed to the persons and vehicles holding the official ABP paddock passes (seasonal or one event).

Trailers/dollies must have Jet Ski's numbers and/or rider's name on the tongue for identification. Teams shall maintain flow patterns through the pit area, and shall not go against traffic.

There shall be no smoking or open flames at the wet or dry pit area at any time.

No alcohol is allowed in the pit area and drinking of alcohol is forbidden for team members during event hours. Any person holding a permanent UIM ABP pass can be checked at any time during event hours.

LAUNCHING

Jet ski will be launched and idled to the designated holding area. Paddock crew of maximum 2 members should be at the start area to position riders. When launching starts, the commissioner's orders must be strictly followed.

START

The start shall be according to UIM ABP rules.

Only uniformed crew members will be allowed on the launch ramp (max. 2 per jet ski). These crew members must be members with ABP passes.

The start of each Moto is scheduled to be a **PONTOON** start with rope. All Aquabikes participating in the Grand prix are required to have **2 tow rings** on their transom (see pictures for reference). Two holders are allowed for runabout, one/two holders for ski division.

Holders must wear all safety gear and gloves and for no reason roll the rope around their wrists. TEST start is scheduled before the start of free practice for each category. All AB must be present at start pontoon 10' before the start of their session or as instructed by the pontoon marshall.

JOKER LAP

As a joker lap, Riders are required to complete a minimum of two passages on each alternate circuit before the conclusion of the race. Riders who fail to comply will incur a 20 second time penalty added at the end of the Moto.

FINISH

The chequered flag signals the finish of the race.

The top three finishers must proceed immediately to the podium for the award presentation. For the prize giving riders must wear their wet suit, racing gear, racing helmet and the official ABP racing bib. This presentation is the provisional classification and is subject to revision after examining all relevant evidences and technical inspection.

The team managers of the top three finishers will accompany the jet ski to the inspection area immediately following the final event.

Immediately after the race the top three finishers must be available for the press conference and TV interviews.

GENERAL

Officials, staff, participants, their crews, families and sponsors will be subject to disciplinary action for their conduct in connection with all UIM ABP events at all times. Penalties may be assessed to the owner and/or rider for unsportsmanlike conduct of their crew members, families and sponsors, as well as to the offenders themselves.

Unsportsmanlike conduct includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Verbal abuse of participants, crew members, family members, sponsors, officials or staff
- Physical violence
- Threats
- Public obscene language
- Public statements or actions with a negative impact on the sport and or UIM/ABP
- Refusal to obey an order from a race official
- etc.

Penalties, as decided by the AB Daily Management and/or AB Committee, for unsportsmanlike conduct will be assessed by the UIM officials, the officer of the day or the UIM protest judge.

Any rider, crew member or official who is injured must report to the first aid centre for examination.

Riders participate in the race at their own responsibility and must have the necessary accident and life insurance.

Registration may be refused to any rider with outstanding financial issues with the UIM, ABP or the Local Organising Committee.

PROTESTS

Protests can be logged at the race secretariat within 1 hour from the time of posting of the results. The protest fee is $150 \in$.





PENALTY FEES

All penalty fees assessed during the event must be paid prior to participation in any subsequent Session.

Penalty fees cannot be subject to protests or appeals.

DURING EVENT ACTIVITIES

The participation of riders and team manager is compulsory to all the activities (Registration, Briefing, Prize giving podium and Official Gala dinner) scheduled on the Official event timetable, unless differently specified by ABP.

On the podium, all riders must wear their wetsuit, racing gear, including the racing bib, and carry the racing helmet. The racing bib must be worn for all pre- and post-podium interviews.

REGISTRATION FEE

To pre-register, complete the Registration Form online (<u>https://www.aquabike.net/events/2025/world-championship-circuit/grand-prix-of-indonesia</u>).

For all non-contracted riders, it is possible to benefit from an early bird discounted fee when registering by 1st of July 2025 of $350 \in$.

For all non-contracted riders registering from 2nd of July, a fee of 400 € will apply. For Freestyle category, engagement is free.

Kindly note that in order to benefit from the early-bird rate, the following must be done by 1^{st} of July 2025:

- Complete official registration form online
- Bank transfer payment of 350 € made to ABP account. Details will be provided as soon as the registration form is received.

N.B: Registration will not be completed until the rider will take the official profile picture on-site. Not taking the profile picture will incur in a fine of 150€.



PADDOCK

The paddock area is adjacent to the sea (location can be seen on the above map) and will open from 09h00 Thursday 14th August. Official participants will need a seasonal or one-event pass to access the area. Each one-event registered rider will be granted the following:

- 1 Rider pass
- 2 Mechanics passes to access dry and wet pit areas


